Brews&Spirits Expo:

Brews & Spirits Expo, now in its 5th edition, is a dedicated trade fair and conference for the production of beer, wine, and spirits. The country is at an inflection point and according to the International Spirits and Wines Association of India (ISWAI), its alcoholic beverage industry, which is currently contributing 2% to the country's GDP, is poised to reach \$64 billion in the next five years, driven by factors such as rising incomes, urbanization, increased access, premiumization and a younger consumer base (100 million new legal drinking age consumers are projected in the next 5 years). It is anticipated that India will become the fifth-largest global market for alcoholic beverages in the near-medium term.

Startup boom and innovation

The Indian alcobev industry is undergoing a premiumization journey, with alcoholic beverage startups experiencing a boom. These innovative players are disrupting the market with authentic, high-quality local and traditional craft liquors, carving niches in premium and semi-premium segments. Leveraging advanced production techniques, indigenous ingredients, and global collaborations, they position themselves as leaders in the global market.

Segmental trends and premiumisation

Dynamic changes are observed across segments, with whiskey remaining dominant while beer gains popularity as a result of social drinking trends and the rise of craft breweries. Wine and Gin, experiencing a global resurgence, also show impressive growth, reflecting a consumer shift towards premiumization and experimentation.

International influence and FTAs

Major international brands entering the Indian market further contribute to the growth of the premium segment. The Free Trade Agreement (FTA) with Australia, signed in 2022, is expected to boost foreign investment by reducing tariffs on imported alcoholic beverages, making them more affordable for Indian consumers.

In the heart of this thriving landscape, the Brews & Spirits Expo acts as a catalyst, propelling India's alcobev sector into new dimensions by fostering connections, knowledge exchange, and showcasing the latest innovations. The trade fair and conference play a pivotal role in steering the industry towards unparalleled growth.
